We have redesigned the exhibit to allow NJ residents to submit work inspired by a garden and created in any medium. The work will be juried by the GGS Committee.

Interns - We offer internship possibilities for college age students, to work with and to learn from the professional artists in residence, and guest artists, within our membership, and beyond. Interns are selected from a pool of applicants, who work throughout each season, in a cross-disciplinary manner, unparalleled in augmenting standard academic training. On average 8-10 interns have been offered this opportunity each season.
