Dance

A dazzling Holiday Dance Spectacular performance by area dance schools and presented on stage at an area High School. Other educational and professional performances are part of our season.

Literature

The literary discipline is growing in new directions, with the start of a series of creative works and workshops. Our new Literary Magazine, "Arsenal" 'where the pen is mightier than the sword' begins its debut unveiling this season, both in print and online.

Media/Film

We are beginning work with a film and new media festival and a series of creative workshops, as well as media, film, and audio productions.

Music

The **Edison Symphony Orchestra** is a world class symphonic ensemble. The list of renowned guest artists who have played with the Symphony spans the globe, including: two-time Grammy Award winner **Jack Jones**, Emmy Award winner **Ann Jillian**, The **von Trapp** children (of "Sound of Music" fame), world renowned classical guitarists **The Romeros**, Broadway singer **Andréa Burns** and Metropolitan Opera tenor **James Valenti**. The **EAS** and **ESO** presented to the community, critically acclaimed pianist, and Van Cliburn Award winner, **Olga Kern**, in a special concert appearance. This season also marks the debut of the EAS Big Band Jazz Masters.

Theatre

We are developing a professional repertory theatre with a vibrantly dramatic season, representing select works from among dramas, comedies, musicals, operas, and special performances. We also have a strong commitment to educational & social service outreach.

Visual Arts

Fine Art Classes – Classes and workshops will be offered in various mediums based on the availability of qualified teachers and mentors.

Gallery Exhibits – Offers non-juried and juried opportunities for artists to share and display their work in Open Statewide and Nationwide exhibits as well as Members Only Exhibits. The Gallery of The Edison Arts Society at the Township of Edison Municipal Building, is home to our main exhibits, while other venues include Middlesex County College Performing Arts Center Studio Gallery and our annual "Artistry in the Garden Tour."

"Gardens of the Garden State" Exhibition – This year, the exhibit will be hung at the Gallery of the Edison Arts Society at the Edison Municipal Building. We have redesigned the exhibit to allow NJ residents to submit work inspired by a garden and created in any medium. The work will be juried by the GGS Committee. New exhibits which will include national and international opportunities are being planned.

Internship

Interns - We offer internship possibilities for college age students, to work with and to learn from the professional artists in residence, and guest artists, within our membership, and beyond. Interns are selected from a pool of applicants, who work throughout each season, in a cross-disciplinary manner, unparalleled in augmenting standard academic training. On average 8-10 interns have been offered this opportunity each season.

Gala

Annual Gala Celebration – Each year an EAS Medal of Honor Recipient is chosen for this annual fundraiser, with a truly magical evening of exceptional performances. Each Honoree has demonstrated their love of the arts and their overwhelming desire to further its reach.
